## Legislative Redistricting Committee Public Hearing Schedule Updated

SALT LAKE CITY – The Legislative Redistricting Committee updated two public hearing dates. The Legislative Redistricting Committee will hold public hearings across the state to gather input, listen to constituents and receive feedback once the 2020 U.S. Census data is released. While inperson attendance is encouraged, public hearings will have a virtual option.

Utahns are encouraged to draw their own map to recommend to the committee using a state-of-theart map drawing tool that will be available on the committee's <u>website</u> in the fall.

Due to COVID-19 delays, the data is expected in mid-August, and the software for drawing maps should be available by early September. The Legislative Redistricting Committee will announce additional details regarding the data as new information becomes available.
