Legislative Redistricting Committee Wraps Up Statewide Public Hearing Tour

SALT LAKE CITY – Utah's Legislative Redistricting Committee recently concluded its statewide public hearing tour. The committee held over a dozen meetings across the state, gathering feedback, reviewing maps and listening to Utahns concerns.

"I, along with the entire committee, want to express appreciation to the individuals who attended the redistricting meetings," said Sen. Scott Sandall, co-chair of the Legislative Redistricting Committee. "The purpose was to listen and gather input from Utahns. The maps, ideas, concerns and insights we received will help us draw district boundaries that best represent our state for the next 10 years."

The committee saw great participation from engaged citizens. Hundreds of Utahns attended the committee meetings in person and online, and nearly 100 maps were shared with the committee.

"We appreciate all who submitted and discussed maps, shared their thoughts and opinions, and attended our public hearings," said Rep. Paul Ray, co-chair of the Legislative Redistricting Committee. "Visiting various parts of the state and hearing from hundreds of Utahns provided invaluable input that will greatly influence our work as we draw and consider Utah's maps for the next decade."

The Independent Redistricting Committee will present its maps to the Legislative Committee on Monday, November 1 at 2:00 p.m at the Capitol Complex. The meeting is open to the public and will be streamed live.
